Concerning: Senate Appropriations for Civic Engagement Week

- Whereas, Civic Engagement Week is one of Student Government Associations largest event, spanning a weeklong taking place on October 28st-November 1st; and
- Whereas, it is the goal of Student Government Association to educate Concordia students about the affairs of the world and encourage the body to be civilly engaged; and
- Whereas, Civic Engagement Week directly meets this goal and the College’s mission to send “thoughtful and informed” students into the world; and
- Whereas, Civic Engagement Week will feature a variety of events to engage the student body and the Fargo-Moorhead community, including a Keynote Speaker, Community Service and Outreach event, Letter Writing Campaign, Community Involvement Expo and a Social Activism Panel; and
- Whereas, Civic Engagement Week is directly organized by the Civic Engagement Advocate; and
- Therefore, it is requested that \$1,600 be allocated to the Civic Engagement Week initiative through the Senate Discretionary Fund. \$1,500 for keynote speaker Erin Maye Quade’s honorarium and \$53.50 for catering services. And, \$26 for supplies related for the letter writing campaign, and \$45 for costs relating to the community service event through the logistics fund.
